# You are taller in the morning Navy Vets Seeking **Bonus Involve State** In Record-Hunting

Pennsylvania is the only bonus paying state that has taken on itself the burden of substantiating foreign duty claims of all its Navy veterans, the State Dept. of Military Affairs said this week. At the same time the depart-ment disclosed that Navy payment disclosed that Navy payments have been considerably stepped up by the Veterans Compensation Bureau's new speed-up plan of processing those claims.

It was pointed out that most other states simply pay all Navy claims at the domestic rate of \$10 a month and then have the applicants themselves prove concluplicants themselves prove conclusively their periods of foreign duty to get the extra \$5 per

month.

Unlike Army discharge papers which provide all required information not mation, Navy discharges do not specify the exact periods of for-eign service to verify the \$15 a month foreign compensation.
"Some states have literally

thrown up their hands over the Navy discharge problem," a spokesman said, "and accepted affidavits from applicants attest-ing to foreign service claims." The bonus bureau said that the Navy claims will amount to about 25 percent of the potential total of 1,215,000, although Navy appli-cations now represent almost 40 percent of all that are being pro-


