

# First-Hand Account of Communists Is Heard By Carrolltown Sodality

## Kazimir Goes Behind Iron Curtain Last Year

Paul Kazimir of Homestead was the principal speaker at the annual Communion Breakfast of the Sodality of St. Benedict's Catholic Church, Carrolltown, last Sunday morning in the Central Hotel, Carrolltown.

Forty-one Sodality members were present at the affair. The Spiritual Director said Grace before the meal. Immediately following the breakfast, the group sang a hymn in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Misses Catherine Harrigan and Kathleen Eck, the toastmistresses, in turn introduced the guest speaker.

Mr. Kazimir is an outstanding opponent of Communism. He has fought Communism in lectures, writings, and radio broadcasts. Besides being a director of schools in Homestead, he is Clerk of the Orphans Court in Allegheny County, Editor of a popular national Slovak newspaper, and has a daily radio program over Station WHOD, Homestead. Mr. Kazimir is an outstanding Catholic layman and civic leader in Western Pennsylvania.

During the latter part of 1949, he toured Europe for four months in the interests of the National Catholic Welfare Council. He visited and inspected the Displaced Persons Camps making first hand reports of all that he saw. The misery, suffering and malnutrition were appalling. He related his experiences with trigger happy Red soldiers, and his daring entry behind Russian lines to make a 22-minute broadcast to the people of Slovakia from a secret radio station.

Mr. Kazimir told the Sodality from his experience with the Reds and from his talks with the inmates of the DP Camps, he learned that the Russians have used force, threats and fear in gaining control and the countries they have subjugated to their regime.

"Don't let anyone kid you, that the same thing can't happen here in America," he said. "The same fate can befall us unless we realize our duties as American citizens."

Mr. Kazimir went on to relate how the Reds are pillaging Catholic Church and Convents. The people defend their priests and church property with pitchforks and any other suitable armament. However, pitchforks are no defense against Red machine guns.

Church services are supervised by the Red regime. Death is the penalty for any priest that deviated from the prepared sermon given to him. "Despite the diabolical cunning of the Communist regime, the people still continue to attend church services," the speaker said.

The speaker also urged the Sodality to be active in church and civic affairs. He urged a strong cooperation with their pastor and stressed the need for attending meetings, both civic and religious, and to vote for good, intelligent citizens.

He stressed the fact that Communists have made inroads into our government and into our unions, and that only external vigilance and careful, wise voting will keep our America free from the diabolical cunning of the Communists.

The speaker said the greatest thrill of his life was a special audience with His Holiness Pope Pius XII.

Following the main address, Julianna Fees gave a reading entitled, "Lovely Lady Dressed in Blue." The chorus then sang two songs, followed by brief remarks by Rev. Father Nicholas Lesko, O.S.B., assistant pastor of the Parish. A hymn, "Mother Below" was rendered by the group and the annual event was concluded with the Grace After Meals by the Spiritual Director.
