Notice is hereby given that the School District of the Borough of Patton, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, acting through its Board of Directors, intends to adopt a resolution at a meeting of the said School Board to be held on June 5, 1950, at 8:00 P. M. (Daylight Saving Time) at the office of the School Board in the High School Building, Patton, Pennsylvania, by the terms whereof it will levy, assess and impose the following taxes for general revenue purposes to become effective on and after the 5th day of July, 1950, and to continue in effect until the first Monday of July, 1951, pursuant to the authority contained in the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, known as Act No. 481, approved June 25, 1947 as amended.
