





Fuel Tax Funds

To Be Sent Soo

Cities, boroughs and townships that have filed reports in compli-ance with legislation authorizing a quarterly pershent of \$2,500,000 in full tax refunds will be certi-fied for payment, Fred F. Lloyd, Comptroller of the State Depart-ment of Highways, said this past week.

week. A total of 45 cities, 691 bor-oughs, 44 first class townships and 1120 second class townships will have payment of \$2,1051,667, Mr. Lloyd sais: A total of \$448,3322 will be withheld from five cities, 250 bor-oughs, 16 first class townships and 48 second class townships which have failed to file reports as required by Act 23, dated Mar. 24, 1949, the Comptroller stated.

A total of \$15,299 will be with-held from the five cities failing to report, while 250 delinquent boroughs will have \$115,897 with-

held. Sixteen first class townships which failed to file reports will be missing \$50,860 until reports are made. On the other hand, 348 second class townships which have not as jet filed their re-quired reports will not have a to-tal of \$266,270 in their coffers when payments are made.
