The jobs of 3,500 shop employees at the big works of the Pennsylvania Railroad, Altoona, were slashed on May 21. Many of the workers laid off are from the Northern Cambria area.

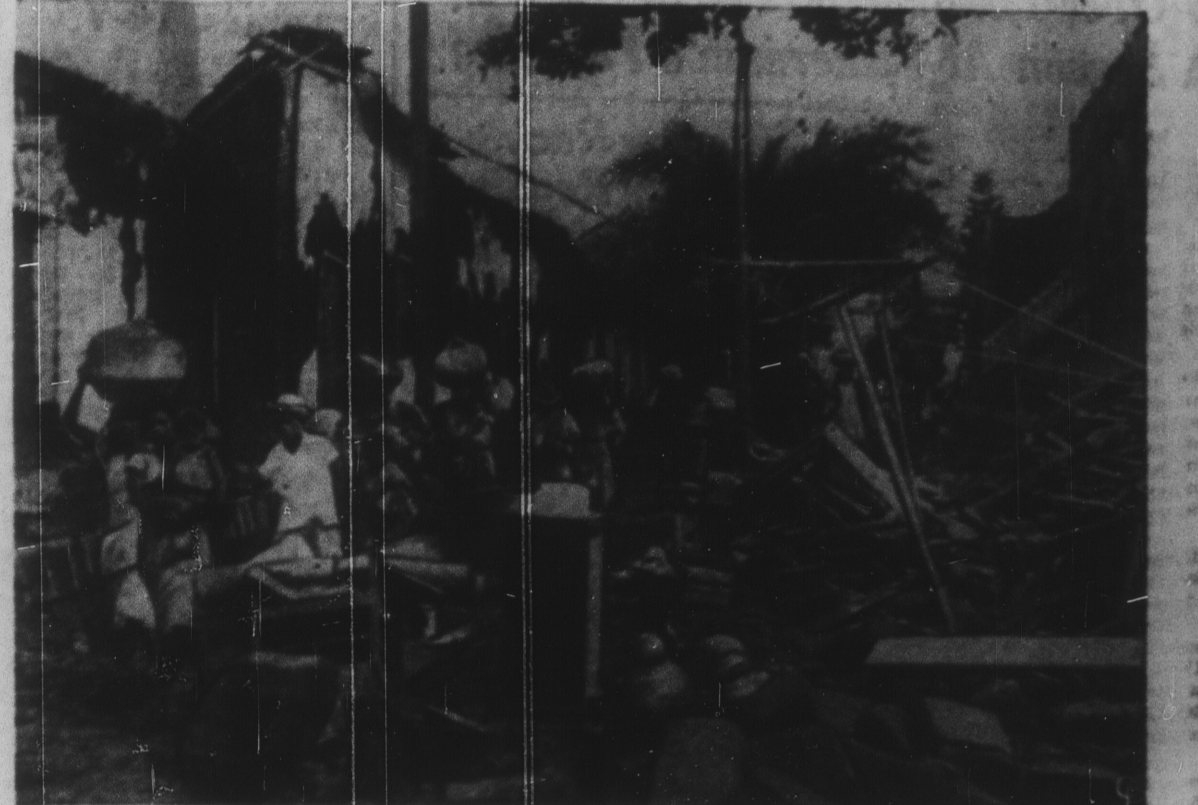
