13-6 Defeat By Revloc

Gallitzin was handed a 13-6, defeat by visiting Revloc last Sunday afternoon, in a Cambria County Grade School Football League game. The winners scored in the opening quarter and the Gallitzin boys of Coach McTavish and B. Longosky made their tally in the last round.

Revloc had a TD about two minutes after the opening kickoff. Gallitzin took the kick off on their own 20 and in three plays lost 10 yards. The losers' punt was partially blocked with Revloc taking over on the Gallitzin 30.

The first downs later Fulton carried the ball for a TD. The second and Revloc score came when Miller intercepted a Gallitzin pass on the losers' 40. A few plays later Sandburg went around end 18 yards to score. He also plunged for the extra point.

The remainder of the game was Gallitzin's holding Revloc at a standstill.

The Gallitzin lads scored their lone tally late in the final frame when McTavish passed 15 yards to R. Litzinger on the Revloc 35 and the speedy end raced for the TD. Christy missed his try for the seven hit point. The Gallitzin TD play was set up when Perry blocked a Revloc punt on the winners' 45 yard line.

Gary Nichol made the longest run of the game when he went around end for 85 yards only to be pulled down from behind on the Revloc 20. The winners took over on downs.

The winners of Bill Mitchell held a 7-8 first down edge and gained 230 net yards to Gallitzin 160. They completed 1 of 5 passes and had 1 intercepted. Gallitzin made good 3 of 4 heaves.
