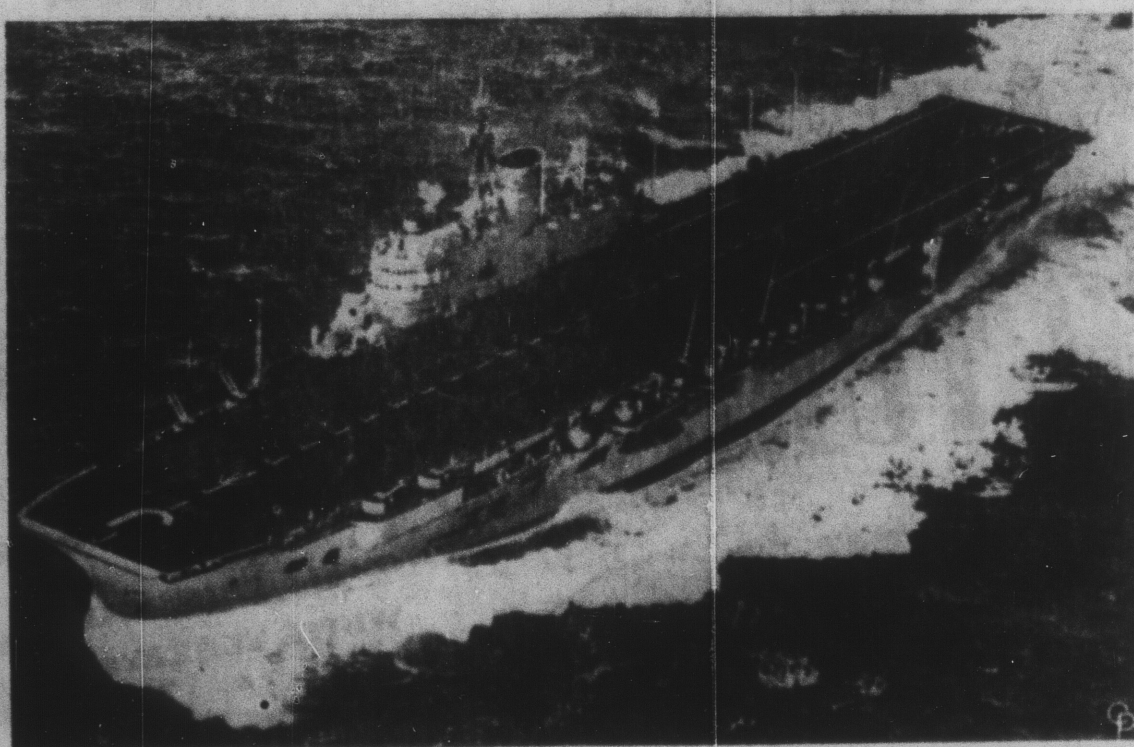

Last Wednesday he admitted to the theft of \$30 from the Colver Athletic Club in Cambria Town-

ship on Nov. 7. On Monday of last week he had pleaded guilty to the theft of materials from a strip-mine operation in West Carroll Township. The loot in the latter theft, committed June 29, was valued at \$26.

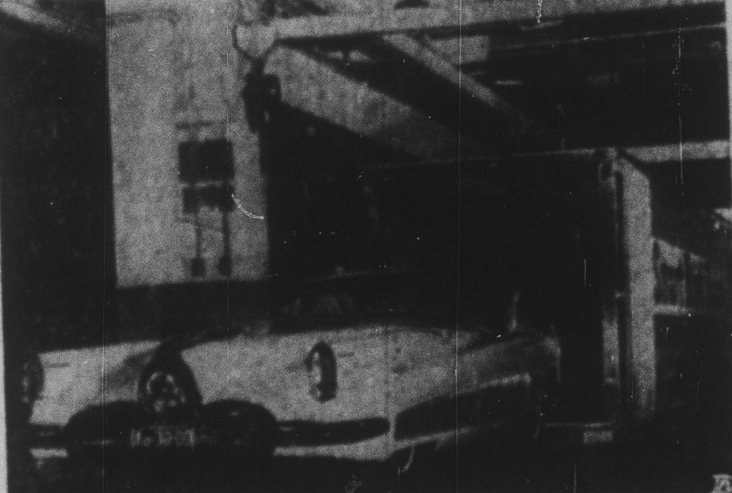
In placing Passerella on probation, the court directed that he

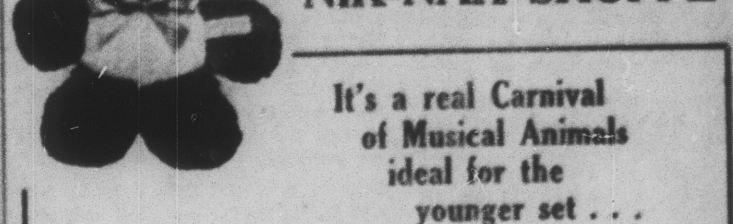
Car of the Future Tours Country
