State's Turkeymen Plan Raising 1 1/2 Million Birds In '52

(By Pennsylvania News Service)

Harrisburg — Turkeymen in Pennsylvania plan to raise a 1952 crop of 1,768,000 birds, or ten percent more than last year.

If these intentions are carried out, 1952 will be the third consecutive year of record breaking production of turkeys in Pennsylvania.

As reasons for the continued increased production of turkeys the introduction and wide acceptance by the consuming public of the Beltville white, a broad-breasted, meaty bird being sold at lighter weights for small family use, plus the fast-growing turkey broiler industry which is beginning to get a foothold in the state.

Pennsylvania farm turkey output at the new record level compares with 1,502,000 birds produced in 1950, and 1,378,000 in 1949, and the 1944-48 average of 1,319,000 birds.

For the United States as a whole, turkey growers have indicated they will raise a record crop of 58,788,000 birds, or an increase of 11 percent over last year. With their 10 percent increase, this put Pennsylvania growers closely in line with national intentions.
