Mrs. Sophie (Hoover) Strittmatter, aged 82 years, wife of Paul A. Strittmatter of Hastings, died at her home at 12:59 p. m. on Sunday, June 15, Mrs. Strittmatter was born on Aug. 12, 1880 in Carroll Township, a daughter of John H. and Anna Mary (Kuntzman) Hoover.

Mr. and Mrs. Strittmatter were married on Oct. 25, 1899 in St. Benedict's Catholic Church, Carrolltown. Mrs. Strittmatter resided most of her 62 years of married life in Hastings, where Mr. Strittmatter was engaged in the lumber and building business until his retirement in 1957.

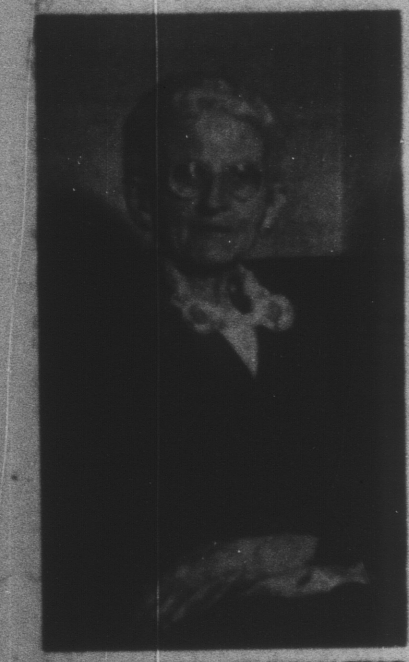
Frank Springer, 89, Dies Suddenly At Carrolltown Home

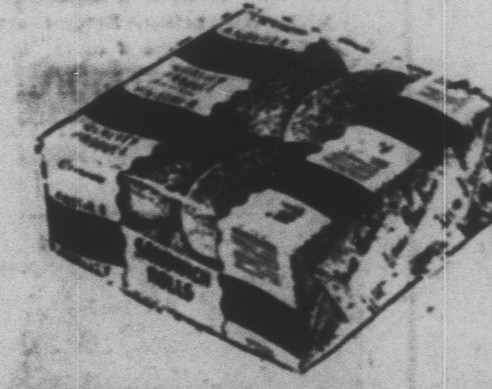
