Clubs Pace First In Bowling Loop

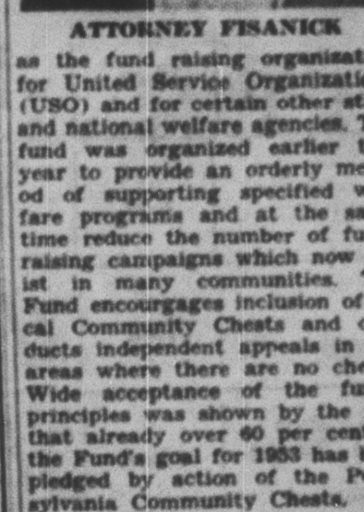
