Barnesboro Television Star Takes Part In Sesqui Events

Joe Maross Assists In Crowning Sesqui Queen

A young man who was seen by millions on television Wednesday night was greeted by hundreds of friends in Cambria County over the weekend.

Joe Maross, formerly of Barnesboro, returned from New York City to take part in festivities in celebration of the county's Sesquicentennial Saturday night. He and Mrs. Betty McAllister, another former area resident and former Mrs. America, crowned the sesqui queen at Sunset Ballroom, Carrolltown.

Maross is a son of Mr. and Mrs. Leo Maross, who now live in Ebensburg.

Area 'Favorite TV Son'

The young actor might easily be dubbed the area's 'favorite TV son.' He's been seen in dozens of television plays.

He managed to squeeze his visit home in between rehearsals for the 'Kraft Theater' on NBC-TV for Wednesday. The program is carried by WJAC-TV from 9 to 10 p. m.

Up at 4 a. m. Saturday, Maross breezed through a film scene needed for the Kraft play, in which he has the starring role. At 8 a. m. he caught a plane to Harrisburg, then another to Johnstown. He landed at 12:30 p. m.

Sunday morning he hoped another plane back to New York where he was due for rehearsal at 1 o'clock in the afternoon.

Veteran of Two Wars

At 31, Maross is a veteran of two wars as a Marine and dozens of plays as a TV actor.

Little over a week ago, he gave a standout performance on 'The Web,' half-hour dramatic show on WJAC-TV Sunday nights.

In Wednesday night's play, 'The Worried Man Blues,' Maross plays the part of a soldier in need of rehabilitation, who is drifting across the country as a bum when he becomes involved in a murder and is arrested.

This was his 12th performance on this program.

Played 49 TV Shows in '58

Last year Maross played in 49 TV shows, live and on film. He's not sure what this year's score is, but it's easily on a par with last year's. There have been times when he has appeared on as many as three dramatic shows in the same week.

On his return to Cambria County over the week end, the former Barnesboro man renewed acquaintances with Aaron K. Howard, director of the sesquicentennial pageant, 'Homeland of the Alleghenies.' The two worked together in a 'Studio One' TV play in New York in January, 1963. After that play, titled 'Signal 32,' they went their separate ways.

Howard joined the John B. Rogers Company of Pottsville, Ohio.

Roberts General Chairman

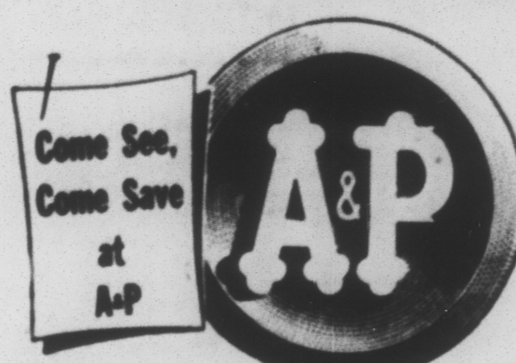
