N. C. Colts Lose to DuBois 26-12 In Game Friday Night

Beavers' Gene Mikelonis Averages 10 Yards Per Carry to Spark Visiting Team to Big Lead

All-State Gene Mikelonis ran like an animal as the triple-threat halfback sparked DuBois High School to a 26-12 win over Northern Cambria High last Friday night before a near-capacity crowd at Extonboro stadium.
