**TAX ORDINANCE.**  
 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF COALPORT, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for fiscal year 1955.

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, that it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Coalport, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

**SECTION 1.** That a tax be levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1955, as follows:

**Tax rate for General Borough Purposes**, the sum of five (5) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**For Debt Purposes** the sum of one (1) mill on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**For other purposes** as follows: Street Lighting: two (2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**SECTION 2.** That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
