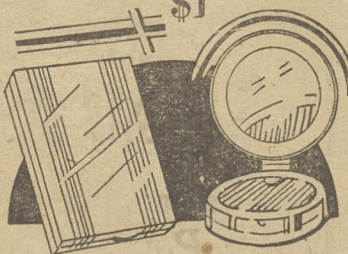

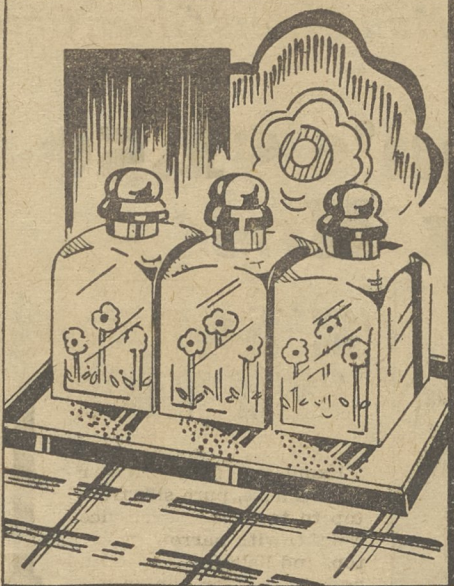
Bath Salts—Richard Hudnut's Three Flowers white granulated bath salts.

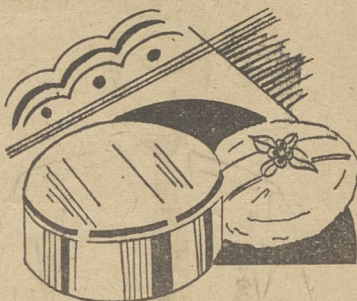


Moire Bags—rubber lined, in all pastel shades. For toilet articles.

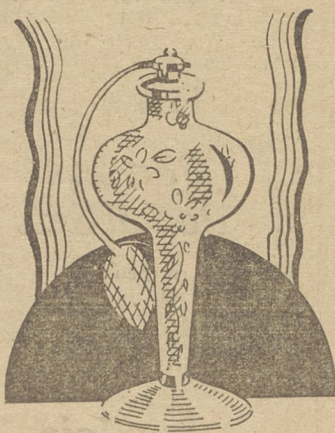

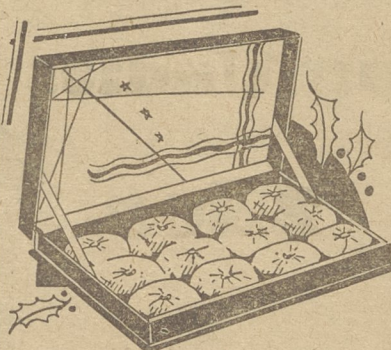
Dusting Powder—in a large tin container, topped with a large velour puff.

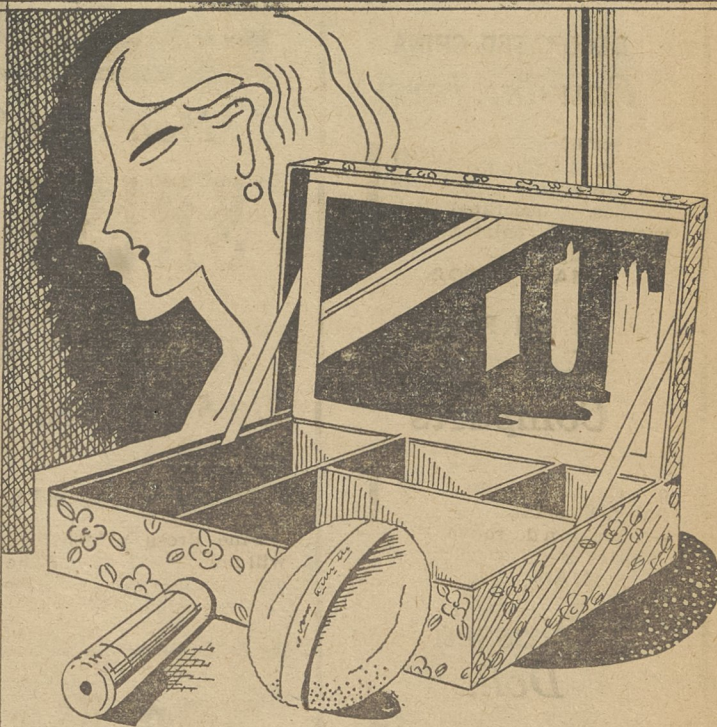
Colored Atomizers—Trimmed with gold, rose, green, blue, yellow. Enmeshed bulb.
