Tomato Juice vs. Tomato Cocktail

Ripe Tomatoes Best

Tomatoes are rich in vitamins A, B and C and contain also that elusive vitamin E, found in so few foods, which mysteriously aids in getting the iron out of other foods which we eat. Did you know that it is no longer necessary to strain the juice from your regular canned tomatoes, because

owing to the popularity of tomato juice, canners now pack the juice ready-strained? And did you know, also, that the tomatoes' vitamins are not lost in the canning process, but are even more potent than those obtained in some fresh tomatoes, which have been picked green, before the sunshine has had time to fulfill its health-giving mission? Try serving as an appetizer a delicious glass of tomato juice—cocktail if you prefer the term—made by mixing two and one-half cups of tomato juice, two teaspoons of malt vinegar, one and one-half teaspoons of salt, one half teaspoon of Worcestershire Sauce, ten drops of tobasco sauce and two teaspoons of lemon juice. Chill and serve with long, narrow, crisp crackers toasted with melted cheese over the top, and a dash of paprika.*
