

## BACK MOUNTAIN BASKETBALL LEAGUE CLOSES ITS SEASON

Dorsett, Lehman, Leads in Scoring-Honors; Richards, Trucksville, Close Second With 97 Points; Phillips, Shavertown, Third With 95 Points Netted

Dorsett, star center of the Lehman basketball team of the Back Mountain League, carried off the honors for points scored for the season just closed. He scored 40 field goals and 8 fouls for a total of 98 points.
