BANK CASHIER IS INDICTED

Three Others To Be Tried On Charge Of Looting Closed Nescospeck Bank

Earl B. Hess, former assistant cashier of Nescospeck National Bank, and three other defendants will be tried during the December term of Federal Court in Harrisburg. They were indicted on Saturday at Scranton.

Charged with Hess on a wide variety of offenses against the national banking laws are William E. Clausen, Sr., owner of Luzerne Hide and Tallow Co., R. D. 1, Nescospeck; Clark E. Rinehimer, garage and service station proprietor, R. D. 1, Wapwallopen, and Marion W. Thompson, Dorrance, a commission agent for the Sinclair Oil Co.

William Hetler, former cashier of the bank, is on probation for three years after having pleaded guilty to having taken \$20,000 from the institution. He has agreed to make restitution.

Government agents charge Hess and his co-defendants are guilty of a maze of allegedly fictitious transactions, unlawful transfers, manipulations and false entries.
