TAX ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF Pringle, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year, 1939.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Pringle, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1939, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of fifteen (15) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation:

For debt purposes, the sum of six and one tenth (6.1) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation: For other purposes, as follows: None.

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of twenty-one and one tenth (21.1) mills.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
