

### Barnyard Notes

Now is the time to plant delphinium seed for bloom next June. Many of the plants I started last August fell by the wayside because they were given too much sun while they were still seedlings, but the six that were wintered in three-inch pots came through beautifully this spring and bore mammoth delft-blue flowers with white bees. A pair of humming birds practically

lived on them during late June and early July. A few mornings ago I gathered almost a quarter of a pound of seed from those six plants. It's in the refrigerator now and will be for a week—the cold hastens germination—then I'll scatter them over the seedpans very lightly covered with dirt and keep them in the dark until the young seedlings come through. When they show their second leaves they'll go in pots and I'll winter them in the cold frames. Next spring I hope I'll have enough blooms to feed

those two humming birds as well as the family they raised this season. If you don't think it takes something to feed a humming bird, just try it sometime.

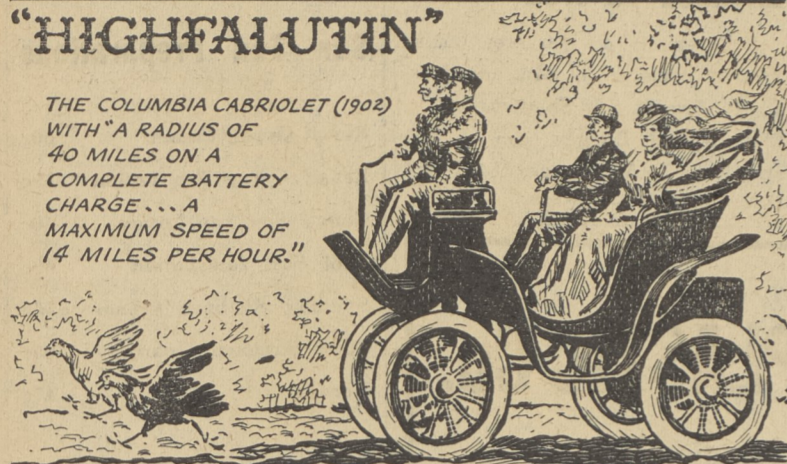

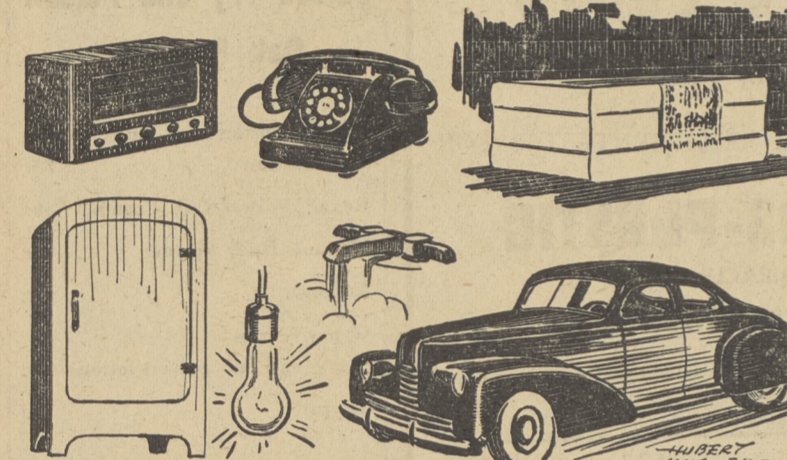

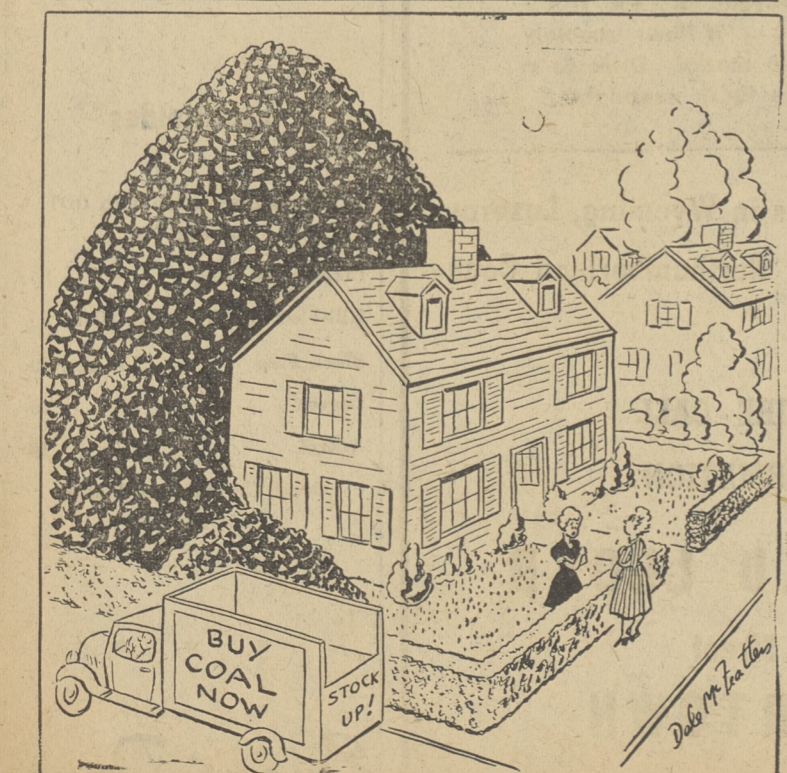
