Walter Derhammer Is Surprised On Birthday

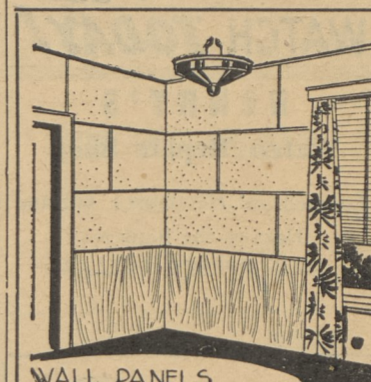
