Mr. and Mrs. Charles Compton of Bethlehem spent the weekend with relatives and attended the funeral of Joy Lamoreaux.

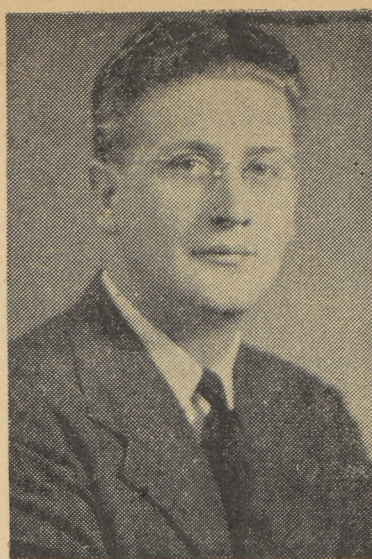
Mrs. Arnett Albee and Mrs. Howard Spray spent Friday with Mr.
