Water Company Makes Refunds

Represents Overcharge Made in September

An estimated \$1300, collected in error from consumers served by the Dallas and Shavertown Water Companies, is being refunded.

The money, representing a rate increase authorized by the Public Utilities Commission to be put into effect October 1st, was collected erroneously from the consumers for the quarter ending September 30.

The refunds amount to about \$1.50 for each of the 550 consumers of the Shavertown Water Company, and about 75 cents for each of the Dallas Water Company's 600 consumers.

Mr. Dungey was also one of sixteen charter members of the Post when organized in 1934. Today it has a membership of 144.

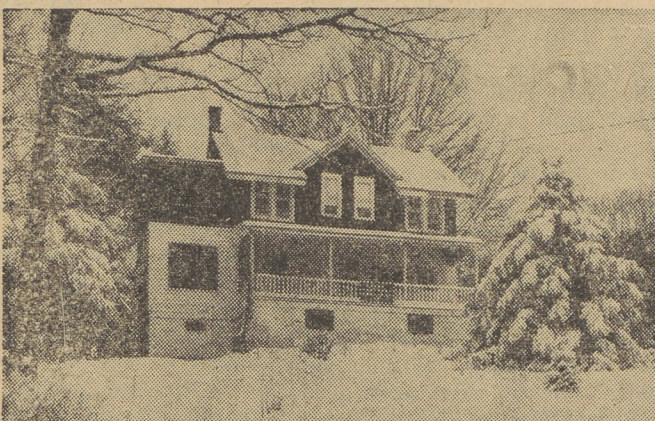

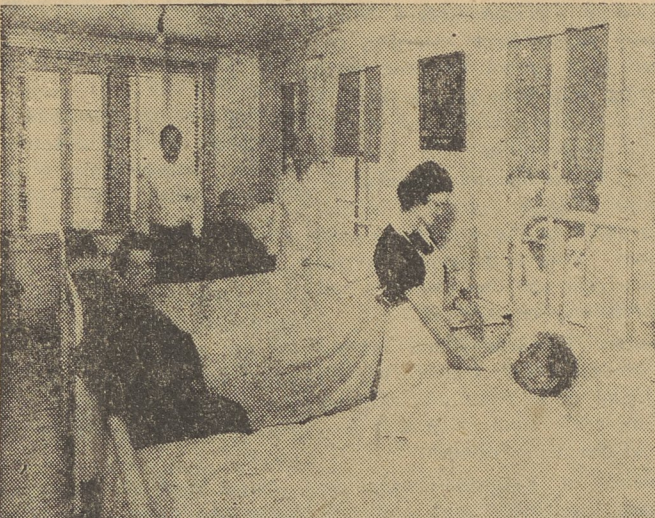
Rotary Club To Attend Trucksville Services

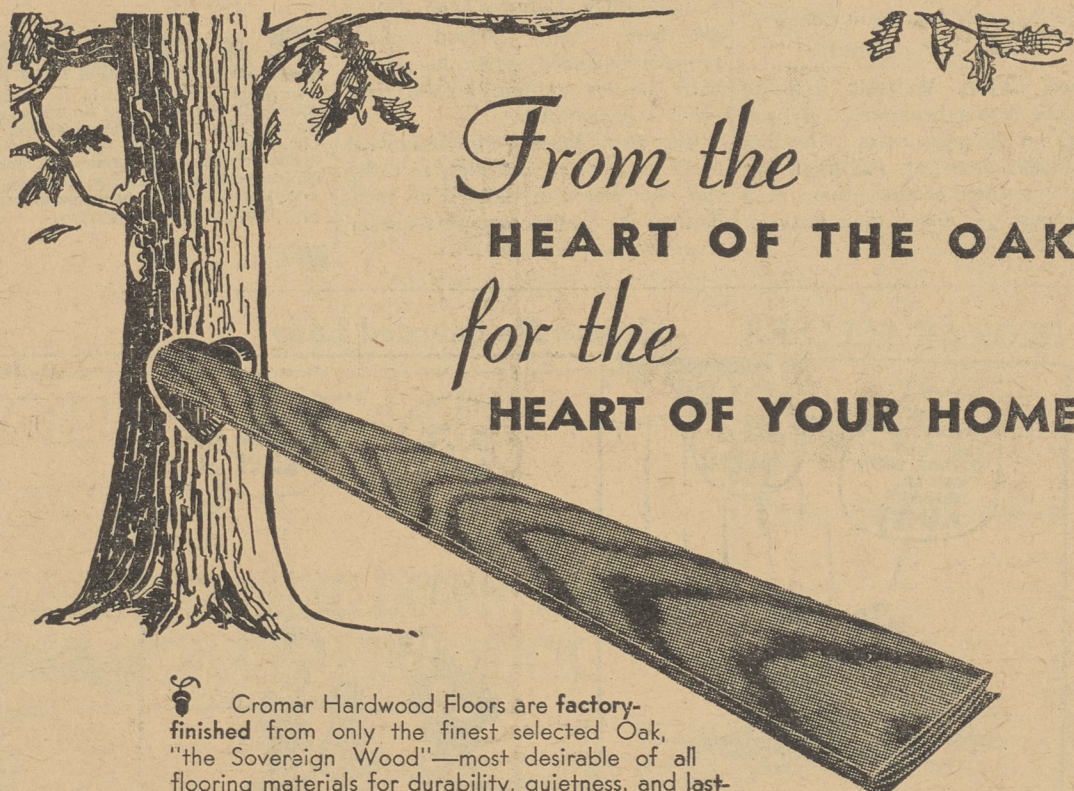
