(daylight saving time), at the School Building, owned by said District, in the village of Orange, Franklin Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, the following unused and unnecessary lands and buildings:

All that certain piece or parcel of land situate in Franklin Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point in the northerly right of way line of a public highway leading to Wyoming, said point being also in the dividing line between lands of the School District of Franklin Township and land now or late of Memorial Shrine Cemetery; thence along line of lands of aforesaid Memorial Shrine Cemetery North 27 degrees 20 minutes West 62.66 feet more or less to a stake in an old pine stump; thence along lands now or late of Winifred Schweizer North 51 degrees East 141.05 feet more or less to a point; thence along lands now or late of Mrs. Mary Grauzlas South 30 degrees 52 minutes East 52.96 feet more or less to a point; thence along the Northerly right of way line of the aforesaid public highway South 47 degrees 30 minutes West 146.5 feet more or less to the place of beginning.
