Firemen Share In State Fund

\$1,553.30 Distributed To Local Companies
Auditor General Weldon B. Hey-burn announced this week that he has approved payments to total-ing \$788,799.38 to the Firemen's Relief Fund Association in sixteen counties.

The monies represent the two per cent tax in the premiums of fire insurance policies written within the political subdivisions in which the Relief Association is located, by companies whose main office is outside the boundaries of the Commonwealth. The money is forwarded to the treasurer of the municipality, who turns it over to the Relief Association of the fire companies or fire depart-ment, paid or volunteer, serving that community, and which are duly recognized by the councils, boroughs and townships.

Amounts distributed in the Back Mountain area are: Dallas Borough \$431.87; Dallas Township \$208.45 to Dr. Henry M. Laing Fire Com-pany; Jackson \$75.52 to Jackson Volunteer Fire Company; Kingston Township \$363.69, to Trucks-ville and Shavertown Volunteer Fire Companies; Lake Township \$347.21 to Daniel C. Roberts Fire Company; Lehman Township, \$125.56 to Leh-man Volunteer Fire Company. No report is available for Ross Town-ship.

is well in hand. The company's plan to dynamite several wells has been abandoned since State Health authorities vetoed the plan as likely to contaminate the supply. A new pipeline has been installed from Ridge to Orchard street and the Lehigh well has been lowered 50 feet.

When questioned concerning lack of water in the Pioneer avenue sector, from 5 p. m. each evening until ten o'clock each morning, Leslie Warhola, company manager, said the pump is shut off on the Roushey well each afternoon to build up a supply for the follow-ing day. Mr. Warhola was unable to promise any relief from the shortage until the new well is installed within the next two or three months.
