

**James B. Morton Dies From Heart Attack**

James B. Morton, 66, Hillside street, Harveys Lake, was buried Monday afternoon in Wyoming Cemetery, following funeral services at the J. S. Miller funeral home in Plains, with Rev. Paul W. Keppel, Stella Presbyterian Church officiating.

Mr. Morton, the victim of a sudden heart attack, died at his home on Friday morning. He had been employed for forty years by Wilkes-Barre Lace Company as a lace weaver.

Born at Darvel, Scotland, he came to this country in early youth, married the former Helen McLellan, North Wilkes-Barre, and resided for a number of years in Forty-Fort before moving to Harveys Lake. He remained a member of the Stella Presbyterian

Church, Forty Fort. He is survived by his wife; a son, Hugh B. who is attached to the Patuxent River Naval Air Station, Maryland; three grandchildren; several brothers and sisters in Scotland.
