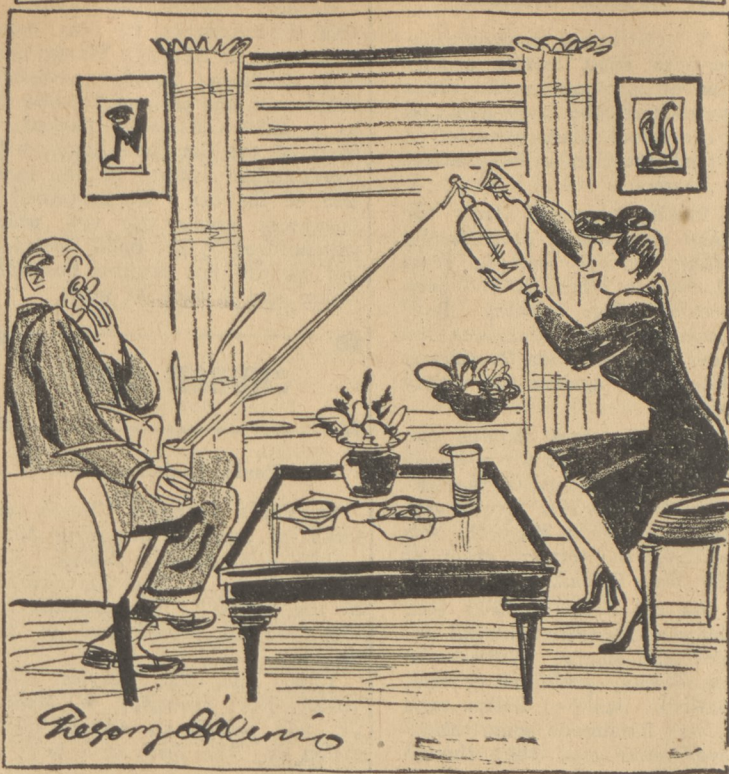
Other officers are Lewis W. LeGrande, Sr., secretary, and R. L. Brickel, treasurer.

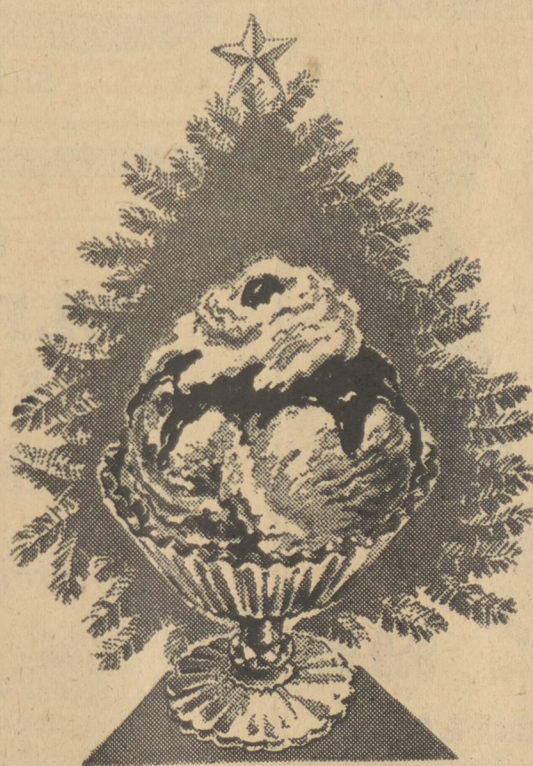
