Purple Heart Award For Robert Kemmerer

Sergeant Robert Kemmerer, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert E. Kemmerer, Pioneer Avenue, Shavertown, was awarded the Purple Heart in a ceremony at the Paramount Theatre Thursday night. This is the third time Sergeant Kemmerer has been home since his transfer from Oakland, California, Hospital to Bethesda, Maryland, late in November.

He was wounded near Seoul in a Marine engagement, left for dead, and later rescued and hospitalized at the Base; flown to Oakland where he was a litter case; thence to Bethesda where he has made rapid strides toward recovery, his good left side compensating for his paralyzed right. He is shortly to have a stainless steel plate inserted in his skull above the left ear to replace the fragmented bone.
