Joint Board Receives Kindergarten Report

Mrs. Charles Eberle reported on Kindergarten registration to Dallas Borough-Kingston Township joint school board Monday evening.

According to Mrs. Eberle's report, 78 children are eligible for kindergarten in September; 43 from Kingston Township, 25 from Dallas Borough, 8 from Dallas Township, and 2 from Jackson. Eight children originally enrolled would be too young for the classes.

Mrs. Eberle's report included accounts of two PTA meetings held

recently, at which kindergarten was discussed. Dr. Charles Swift, Children's Service Center, spoke to Shavertown PTA March 19 on the value of kindergarten in elementary school life. Charles James, Supervising Principal of Dallas Borough Schools spoke to Dallas PTA on the same subject.

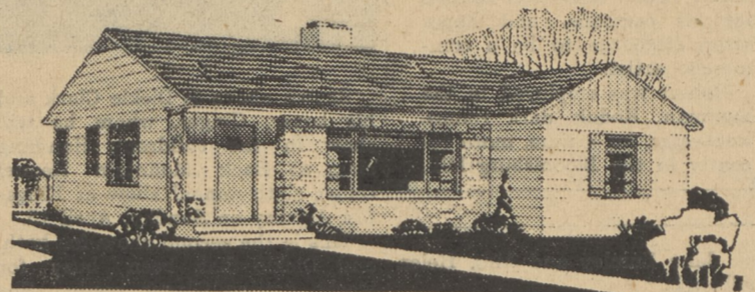
Fred Anderson, member of Kingston Township School Board, advocated serious consideration of a proposal to set up a Kindergarten, saying that it was the wish of the taxpayers and that there was definite need. He moved that it be referred to the finance committee, Lewis LeGrand, chairman, for study of costs of equipment and teachers' salaries. If the kindergarten is to be opened in the fall, he pointed out, delay would be fatal.

Harry Ohlman, President of the Joint Board, stated that the consensus of board members seemed to be that if finances could be man-

aged, the kindergarten should be established. Members of kindergarten survey

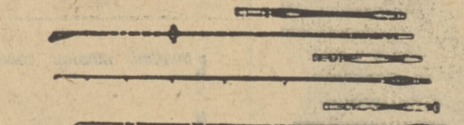
