Meeting Postponed

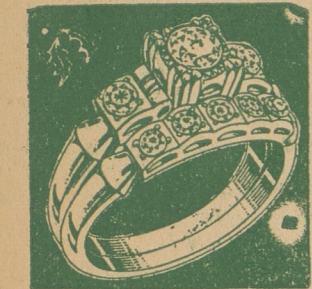
December meeting of Back Mountain Memorial Library Board on Tuesday night was postponed because of the severe storm.
