Be it ordained by the Supervisors of the Township of Lake and t is hereby ordained by the authority of the same as follows: That in order to facilitate the

handling of traffic, the Township Supervisors are hereby authorized through the proper officials to designate certain zones along the highways within said Township wherein no parking shall be allowed. Said no parking zones shall be

conspicuously marked by proper

signs legally erected indicating

that parking is prohibited. Any person or persons parking within a zone wherein no parking signs have been duly placed by Township officials, shall pay a penalty of not less than two (\$2.00) dollars. Which two (\$2.00) dollars penalty may be paid within five (5) days at Police Headquarters, Daniel C. Roberts Fire Co. Building, Harveys Lake, Pennsylvania, thus eliminating further legal process. Failure to pay or remit said minimum two (\$2.00) dollars penalty shall result in issuance of a summons to appear before a Justice of the Peace for prosecution. Where, upon being duly convicted, said person shall pay a fine or penalty of not more than two (\$2.00) dollars together with the costs of prosecution for every such violation and upon default in the payment of such fine or penalty, any person so convicted, shall be committed to jail until he has complied with this ordi-
