

Said ordinance to read as follows: Be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Dallas Township that the considered opinion of the body is that the extension of the Social Security System to employees and officers of the Township of Dallas will be of great benefit not only to the employees of the Township by permitting said employees and officers to participate in the provisions of the Old Age and Survivors Insurance System, but would also be of great benefit to the Township of Dallas by enabling it to attract and retain in employment the best of personnel and thus increase the efficiency of the government.

The 1951 session of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in regular session, enacted a statute, known as Act 491, which is The Enabling Act provided for in Section 218 of Pub-

designated the Secretary of Labor and Industry of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to act as 'state agency" to implement the coverage of employees and officers under the said Old Age and Survivors Insurance System. The Township of Dallas is hereby authorized to execute and deliver to and agreement, required under plans and agreement. The treasurer is hereby authorized to establish a system of payroll deductions to be matched by the payment by the Township of Dallas to be paid into the Contribution Fund of the Social Security Act through the offices of the State Agency and to make charges of this tax to the Fund or Funds from which wages or salary payments are issued to the employees of the Township of Dallas. Such payments are to be made in accordance with the provisioons of the Law and regulations promulgated by the State Agency and the Federal Security Administration.
