Matter of any class weighing over 8 ounces but not exceeding 70 pounds in weight or 100 inches in length and girth combined, including written and other first-class matter, whether sealed or unsealed, is subject to zone rates. Air mail should be conspicuously endorsed "AIR MAIL".
