taking indoor holiday pictures. When shooting indoors leave all room lights on. Even better results may be had by adding a floodbulb to give some detail of room surroundings.

When taking a picture of the Christmas tree indoors, try a ten-second exposure for the lights and then flash a flashbulb in the direction of the tree before the camera shutter closes. You may not get the exact image on the film that your eye sees but, you can get an acceptable print in this way.

Try your indoor tree pictures several ways with and without flash. However, don't attempt a picture with only the tree lights on. Plan your holiday picture taking to include candid flash shots of holiday festivities including Christmas eve, Christmas morning gift opening, holiday family dinners and New Year's Eve parties.
