# Military Rites For Veteran

## George Beretsky Lost Both Legs Under Train

Military rites were conducted for Paul Beretsky at Sacred Heart Cemetery Tuesday morning by Larksville Post 655, American Legion. Requiem Mass at Gate of Heaven was celebrated by Rev. Francis Kane, following services from the home of his parents in Plymouth.

Mr. Beretsky, disabled World War II veteran, resident of Susquehanna Avenue, Dallas, died at Veterans Hospital Saturday morning, having been admitted the previous Tuesday.

He had lost both his legs in 1944 when he fell in front of a subway train in New York on his way back to his ship, USS Champlain, after a Christmas leave. He was honorably discharged from the Navy after hospitalization of over a year.

Born and educated in Larksville, he entered service in 1942.

He is survived by his widow, the former Margaret Backo, Swoyerville; and daughter Nancy, at home; and his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Clarence Nesbitt.
