HINTS for the Handyman

No. 1 Setting Your Mower

Check the setting of the underknife with a sheet of paper. Turn mower upside down and turn blades slowly around—the paper should shear off as cleanly as though cut with scissors. If blades bind—or paper isn't cut across width of blades, correct adjustment of underknife. Screws are provided on mower for this purpose.
