-and they did, for here in these gardens laid out in the form of a butterfly's wings by Anna Hayatt Huntington is represented the greatest collection of American sculpture in existence-all of it in an outdoor setting of live oaks, holly, magnolias, china berries and camelias. There are now 288 works by 156 sculptors.


The Garden settings bring out the best in the sculpture, while its thirteen pools and surrounding walls are heightened by the intensity of the mood, either in harmony or in contrast with the sculpture.


Within the garden walls there are splendid vistas through the flickering shade of great 200-year old live oaks to sunny places beyond. The ground beneath the oaks is always green with English ivy, its emerald tones coming alive in the quick lizards that dart through it and up the boles of the trees.

Here in what were four rice plantations. Mr. and Mrs. Archer Huntington of Connecticut have given 6,635 acres to the people of South Carolina and America. Originally planned to contain the sculpture of Mrs. Huntington, the garden has gradually found extension in collection representative of the history of American sculpture.

To these have been added on marble plaques throughout the garden the verse of some of the writers who have taken pleasure in the beauty of nature and her living forms. In the words of the founder, "In all due homage to science, it may be well not to forget inspiration, the sister of religion, without whose union the world might yet become a desert."
