AN ORDINANCE
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on December 29th, 1953 the Borough Council of the Borough of Dallas, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, duly enacted an ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE BOROUGH OF DALLAS, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF TWENTY - ONE THOUSAND (\$21,000.00) DOLLARS FOR PAYMENT OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF A PROPERTY SITUATE ON THE SOUTH-WESTERLY SIDE OF MAIN STREET, IN THE BOROUGH, IMPROVED WITH BUILDINGS WHICH WILL PROVIDE ROOMS FOR THE MEETINGS OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL, QUARTERS FOR THE HOUSING OF FIRE EQUIPMENT AND OTHER BOROUGH VEHICLES AND SUPPLIES, AS WELL AS FOR BOROUGH OFFICIALS AND OFFICERS, AND, IN ADDITION THERETO, FURNISH A SOURCE OF INCOME BY WAY OF RENTAL FROM CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE BUILDINGS WHICH MAY BE LEASED TO OTHERS FOR RESIDENTIAL OR BUSINESS PURPOSES; APPROVING THE FORM OF THE BONDS AND COUPONS; PROVIDING FOR THE RATE OF INTEREST ON SAID BONDS AND FIXING THE MATURITY DATE THERETO; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT, LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A TAX TO PAY THE INTEREST AND TAXES COVENANTED TO BE PAID THEREON AND THE PRINCIPAL THEREOF AT MATURITY; DIRECTING THE PRESIDENT AND SECRETARY OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL TO PREPARE, VERIFY AND FILE THE REQUIRED STATEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY TO CERTIFY AND FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS COPIES OF THE NECESSARY PROCEEDINGS.

The following is a summary of said Ordinance:

The preamble recites that the net debt of the Borough of Dallas and the debt to be created by the bonds therein authorized in the amount of Twenty-One Thousand (\$21,000.00) Dollars do not exceed the constitutional limitations.

SECTION 1. authorized the issuance of bonds in the amount of Twenty-One Thousand (\$21,000.00) Dollars for payment of the purchase price of a property in the Borough for use as a Borough Building, Fire House, etc. SECTION 2. described the type of bond issue to be issued, the denomination, numbers, date and interest rate. SECTION 3. described the maturities of the bonds and provided for redemption prior to maturity. SECTION 4. provided that the bonds should be issued free of present or future State Tax. SECTION 5. provided for the method of the execution of the bonds. SECTION 6. provided for the form of bond, the form of the coupon and the form of the endorsement. SECTION 7. provided for the pledge of the full faith and credit of the Borough of Dallas for the payment of the principal of the bonds and the interest and any State Tax that may accrue thereon. SECTION 8. provided for the levy of a tax sufficient to pay the principal of the bonds and interest, or any State Tax that may be levied thereon, and made an appropriation of \$210.00 from the general fund of the Borough to meet the interest for the first interest period occurring before the levy of the tax. SECTION 9. provided for the establishment of a Sinking Fund. SECTION 10. provided for the filing of a financial statement in the Court of Quarter Sessions. SECTION 11. provided for the certification and filing of the proceedings relating to the bond issue with the Department of Internal Affairs. SECTION 12. repealed all ordinances inconsistent with said Ordinance.

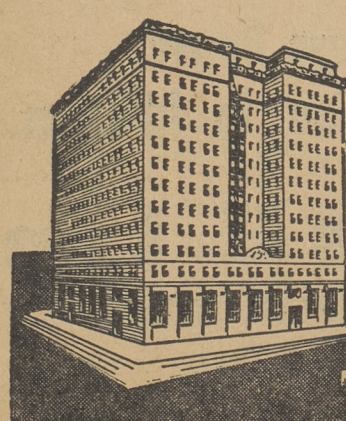
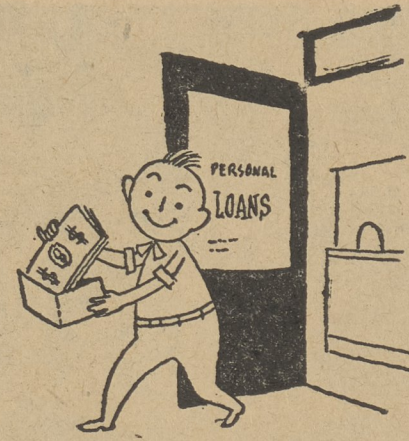
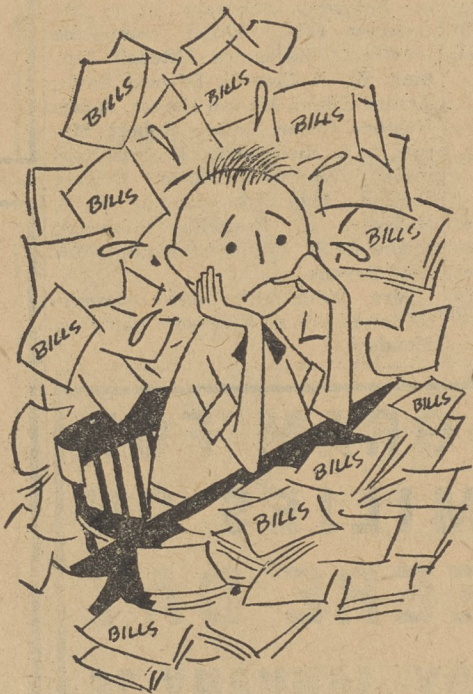
