spoken with today's accent. We shall have to examine our lives to see what holds us back from the richness of the Christian life. The yielding of any habit or way of living, the abandoning of any cherished hate or impure thought, or desire, the humble giving of ourselves without reserve—these are so little to give when we remember that He gave Himself for us.

Love so amazing, so divine Demands my soul, my life, my all. As we share His experience and give ourselves without reserve, we shall enter, understandingly, humbly, gratefully, into the full glory of Easter Day.


