in the fields nearby who saw a hand rise twice from the water and then disappear. They called State Police who found the bodies about three hours later.

The drownings were the third and fourth in Wyoming County this year, Lake Carey and Lake Winola having had similar tragedies. The deaths raised to ten the list of persons dying from accidental deaths in that county since Memorial Day.


