NOTICE
A ZONING ORDINANCE REGULATING THE LOCATION, CONSTRUCTION AND USE OF BUILDINGS, THE DENSITY OF POPULATION, AND THE USE OF LAND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LEHMAN, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Be it ordained and enacted, by the Township Supervisors of the Township of Lehman, at a regular meeting assembled April 7, 1955, that the Township of Lehman is hereby divided into various Zones known as Agricultural, Commercial, Industrial, and Residential, and that following such Zones be, and they are, hereby created and established as follows:

SECTION I. DEFINITIONS
1. Residential—in which only family dwellings are permitted, with small gardens attached, strictly and exclusively residential.
2. Commercial—in which are permitted residences, business establishments, gasoline stations, etc.
3. Industrial—in which are permitted residences, business establishments, gas stations, and in addition thereto, factories, manufacturing plants, etc.
4. Agricultural—in which any use of the above Zones are permitted.

SECTION II. ZONES
INDUSTRIAL
The following highways and the land bounding thereon for a distance of 500 feet from the center line on both sides thereof, are hereby designated as INDUSTRIAL ZONES.

ZONE 1. Pennsylvania State Highway Route 115 from the Dallas Township-Lehman Township line to the Lehman Township-Lake Township line; excepting, however, along said Pennsylvania State Highway Route 115 at Lehman Center, a distance of one-half mile in each direction from the Memorial Plaque,

way Route 115 at the Memorial Plaque in Lehman Center a distance of one-half mile therefrom in each direction.
ZONE 2. Old Pennsylvania State Highway Route 415 from the intersection at Harveys Lake, to a point 3,000 feet South East in the direction of Idetown; also Carpenter Road from the intersection at Harveys Lake 1,500 feet East to the intersection with the road to Idetown; also all of the Pennsylvania State Highway Road following the Harveys Lake shore from Devlin's Dock to the Lehman Township-Lake Township line at Sunset.
An area of 400 feet on either side of the above area or highways, is hereby designated as COMMERCIAL.

RESIDENTIAL
ZONE 1. The road following the shore around Lake Silkworth, Routes

415 (Route 177) from the intersection with 40050 to Idetown intersection; also the Harveys Lake shore road from the Lake Township-Lehman Township line South to the junction with the Commercial Zone on same road; also Old Route 415 from the intersection at Idetown to Lehman Township-Lake Township line at Sunset; also all roads bounding and traversing the building development of Oak Hill; also Route 40060 from the intersection with 42nd Street North to the intersection at Idetown; also Route 40027 from the intersection with Route 40060 to the Lehman Township-Dallas Township line at Sgarlat Lake.
All of the above areas are hereby designated as strictly and exclusively RESIDENTIAL.
An area of 200 feet on either side of the above area, or highways, is hereby designated as RESIDENTIAL.

AGRICULTURAL
All other land in Lehman Township being cultivated land, timber land, streams, ponds and lakes, and not otherwise designated, is hereby designated as AGRICULTURAL.
SECTION III. Topographic maps made by the U. S. Geological Survey are hereby directed to be placed on file in the office of the Township Secretary on which there shall be designated all of the above Zones with the following legend:
INDUSTRIAL ZONE—marked in

ORANGE
COMMERCIAL ZONE—marked in BLUE
RESIDENTIAL ZONE—marked in GREEN.
SECTION IV. No barriers or fences may be erected between commercial properties which might obstruct the free flow of commerce.
SECTION V. There is hereby established a building line at least twenty-five (25) feet from the right-of-way line of every highway, and eight (8) feet from any side line.
SECTION VI. Residential lots shall contain at least six thousand (6,000) square feet of land and the length shall not exceed three times the width thereof, unless such residential lot is fifty (50) feet or more in width.
SECTION VII. All Ordinances and Resolutions or parts of Ordinances and Resolutions inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
