A ZONING ORDINANCE REGU LATING THE LOCATION, CON-STRUCTION AND USE OF BUILD-INGS, THE DENSITY OF POPULATION, AND THE USE OF LAND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LEHMAN LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYL-

Be it ordained and enacted, by the Township Supervisors of the Township of Lehman, at a regular meeting assembled April 7, 1955, that the Township of Lehman is hereby divided into various Zones known as Agricultural, Commercial, Industrial, and Residential, and that following such Zones be, and they are, hereby created and established

SECTION I. DEFINITIONS

1. Residential - in which only family dwellings are permitted, with small gardens attached, strictly and exclusively residential.

2. Commercial—in which are permitted residences, business establishments, gasoline stations, etc. 3. Industrial—in which are permitted residences, business estab-

turing plants, etc. 4. Agricultural—in which any use of the above Zones are per-

SECTION II. ZONES INDUSTRIAL


The following highways and the land bounding thereon for a distance of 500 feet from the center line on both sides thereof, are heredesignated as INDUSTRIAL ZONES.
