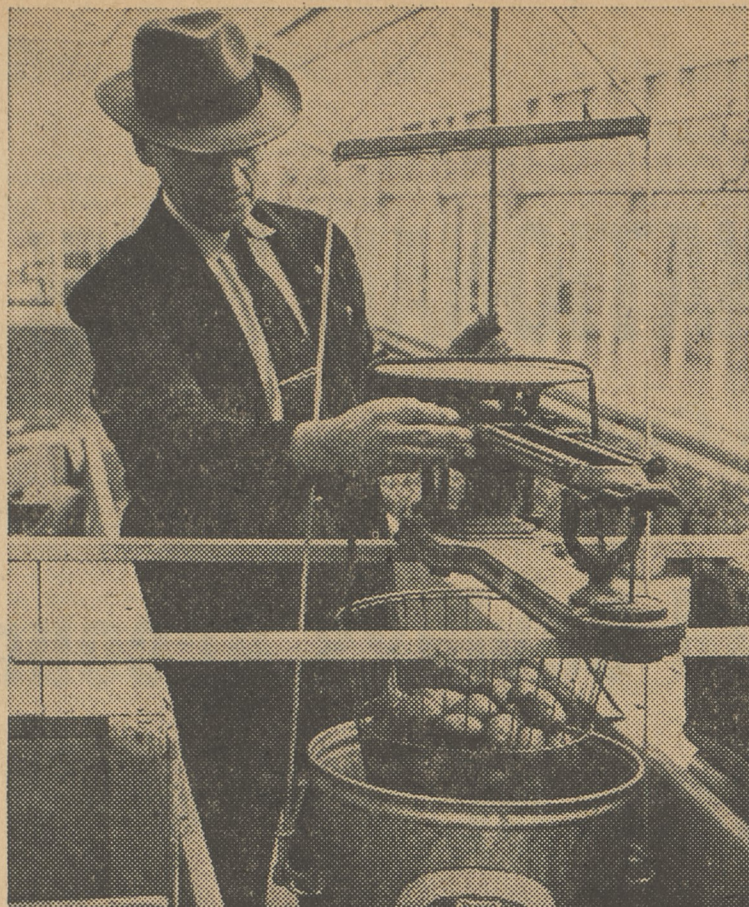

Should you wish to separate the good "bakers" from the "friers" in a bag of potatoes, dunk them after washing in brine made of one cup of salt per gallon of water. This picture shows Cobb making a more scientific test of potato quality, but in general his results will be the same as yours.

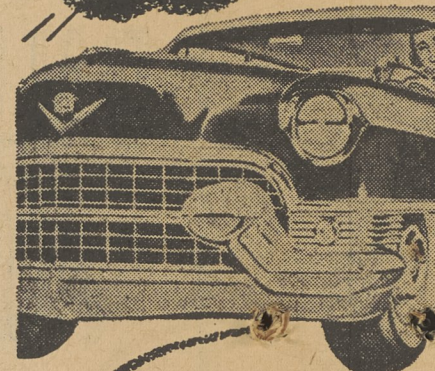

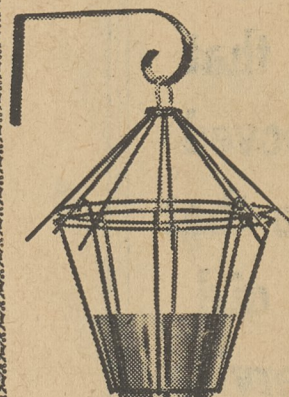

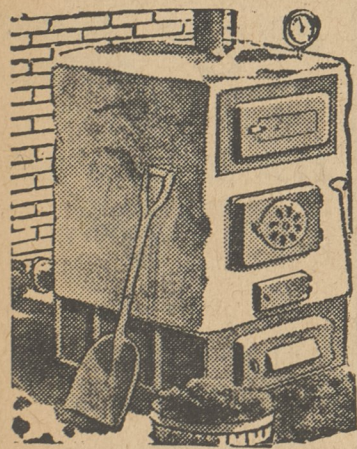
