Currently, the Federation has a bill in the legislature which will increase blind pensions by \$10.00, plus other bills designed to improve the life of the blind.

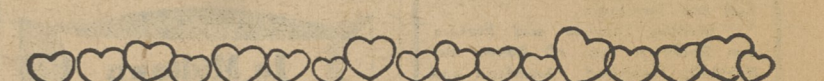
