Greater Number of Legal Size Trout Stocked Than In Any Previous Year

Weather permitting, sportsmen can look forward to a favorable opening of the trout season on Sunday morning, April 15, at 5 o'clock.

According to John I. Buck, State Fish Warden, whose home is at Sweet Valley, streams and lakes of Luzerne County have been stocked with a greater number of legal size trout than in any previous year.

The following give the streams, species and locations of the trout stocked:

Arnolds Creek, Brook Trout, from below Kittles store down stream.

Phillips Creek, Brook Trout, from Route 115 down stream.

Pine Creek, Brook Trout, from the mouth of Wasp Run to Luzerne-Columbia line.

Hunlocks Creek, Brook Trout, from the mouth of the stream to Gregory's Corners.

W. B. Hunlocks Creek, Brook Trout, from the mouth of Peggy Hunter Run to the Rittenhouse Farm.

Little Wapwallopen Creek, Rainbow and Brown Trout, from one-half mile above the mouth to where Township Road H-392 crosses the stream.

Wrights Creek, Brook Trout, from above the Ice Dams up into the State Game Lands.

Lehigh River, Rainbow and Brown Trout, from the mouth of Choke Creek down to below the mouth of Hayes Creek.

Nescopeck Creek, Rainbow and Brown Trout, through State Game Lands.

Oley Creek, Brook Trout, through State Game Lands.

Elm Street Sportsmen Dam, Rainbow and Brook Trout, throughout

the Dam. Lake Silkworth, Rainbow and Brook Trout, throughout the Lake.

Harveys Lake, Rainbow and Brook Trout, throughout the Lake.

These are streams and lakes in the county which have been stocked with trout.
