Fighting Paganism Lesson for June 10, 1956

Did the church conquer paganism? Already in the city of Ephesus, when St. Paul was the main preacher there, Christians ran into trouble. We sometimes think if we could get rid of our preachers and get the Apostles to take charge of our churches for a while, we would eliminate all our troubles; but St. Paul for one would not have agreed with us.

Missionaries of paganism When an army stays for any length of time in a foreign territory, it usually leaves behind it words or phrases which the natives pick up, and which may become a permanent part of the local language.

Paganism's progress Christians too easily sit back in their easy pews and think, Paganism has been licked. St. Paul licked it, or Luther, or Wesley or somebody.

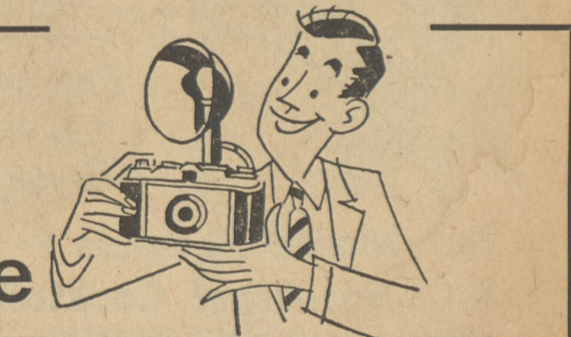

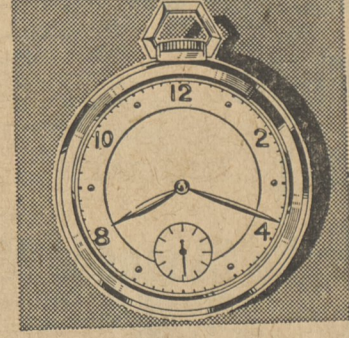
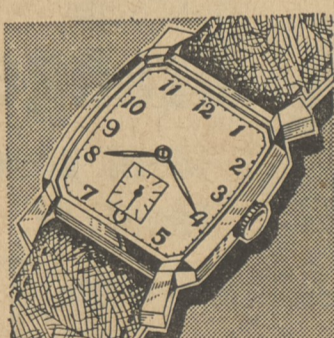
