often heard in connection with rearend collisions. The reason for this excuse is disclosed in reports from both the New Jersey Turnpike Authority and the Pennsylvania Joint Safety Research Group. They discovered that rear-end collisions were significently higher during darkness on straight-up roadway. In fact, John R. Crosby, assistant traffic engineer with the New Jersey Turnpike Authority, reported that twice as many rear-end collisions occur at G F Pts. night as in the daytime.

Theoretically, rear - end collisions could be eliminated if all vehicles on highways could be made to travel 2 at the same speed. However, high-5 out that enforcing a strict program to slow down speeders and speed up 0 crawlers is almost a physical impossibility and a financial improba-2 bility.


