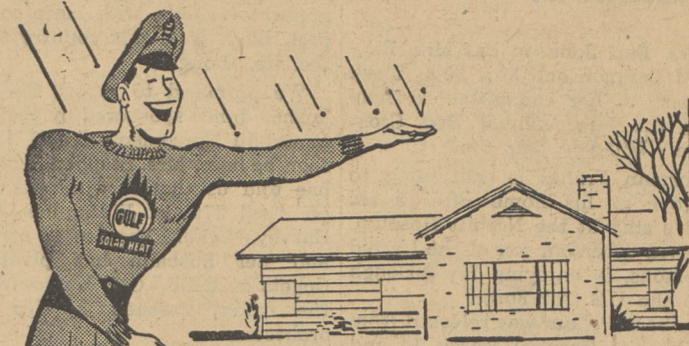

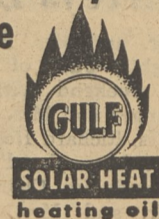
**In Memoriam**

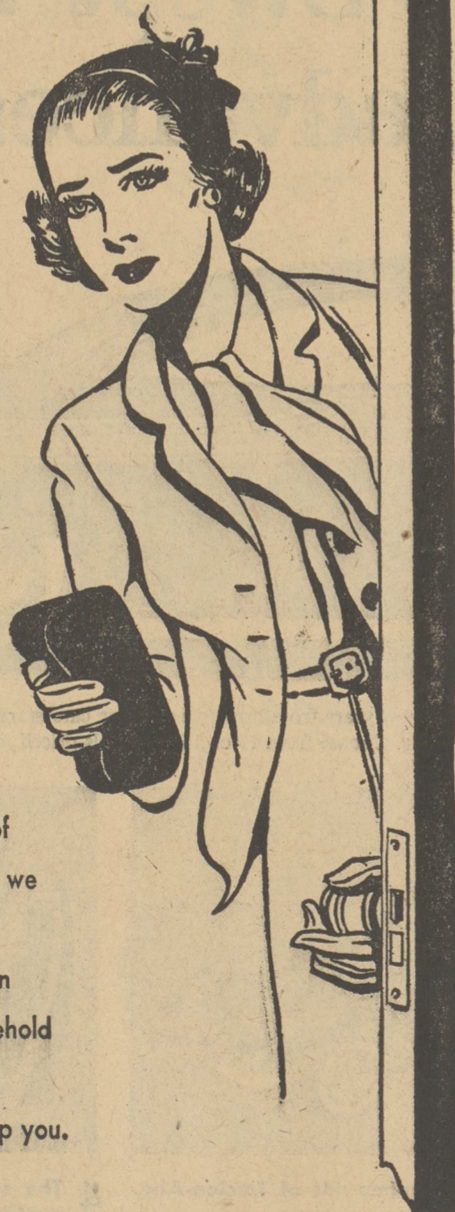

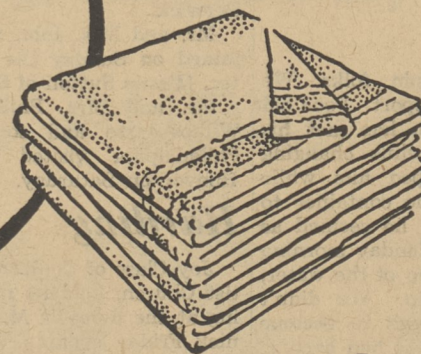
