Bids will be received for the entire issue at any one rate of interest but no bid combining two or more rates of interest will be accepted. The principal and interest of said bonds will be payable at the office of the Luzerne National Bank, Luzerne, Pennsylvania, without deduction for any tax or taxes, except succession or inheritance taxes, now or hereafter levied or assessed thereon under any present or future law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, all of which taxes the Township of Jackson assumes and agrees to pay. 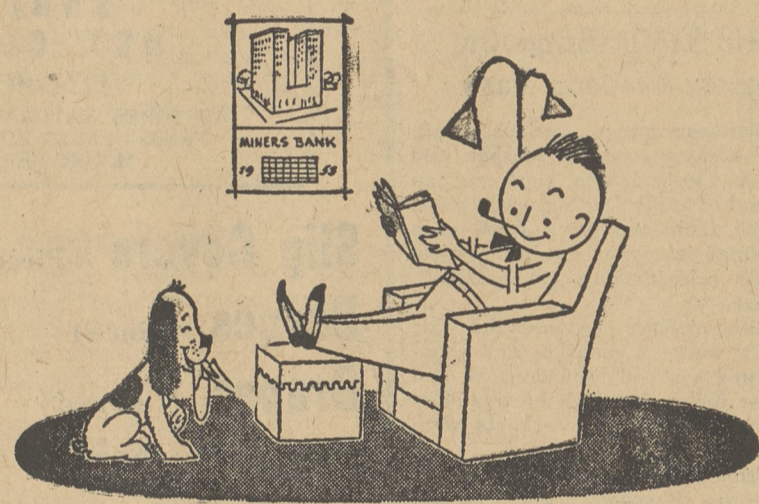

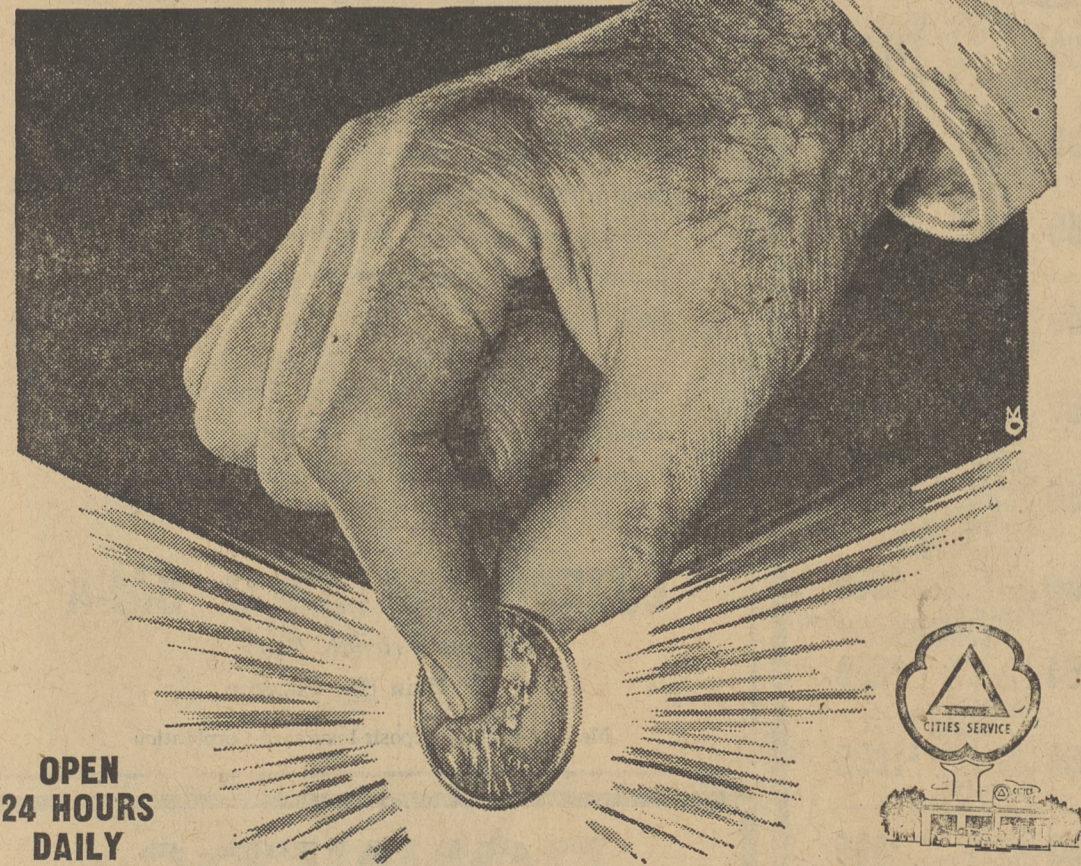
