Persons who have good usable clothing, but can no longer make use of it are invited to call Mrs. Sayre at R. D. 1, Noxen.

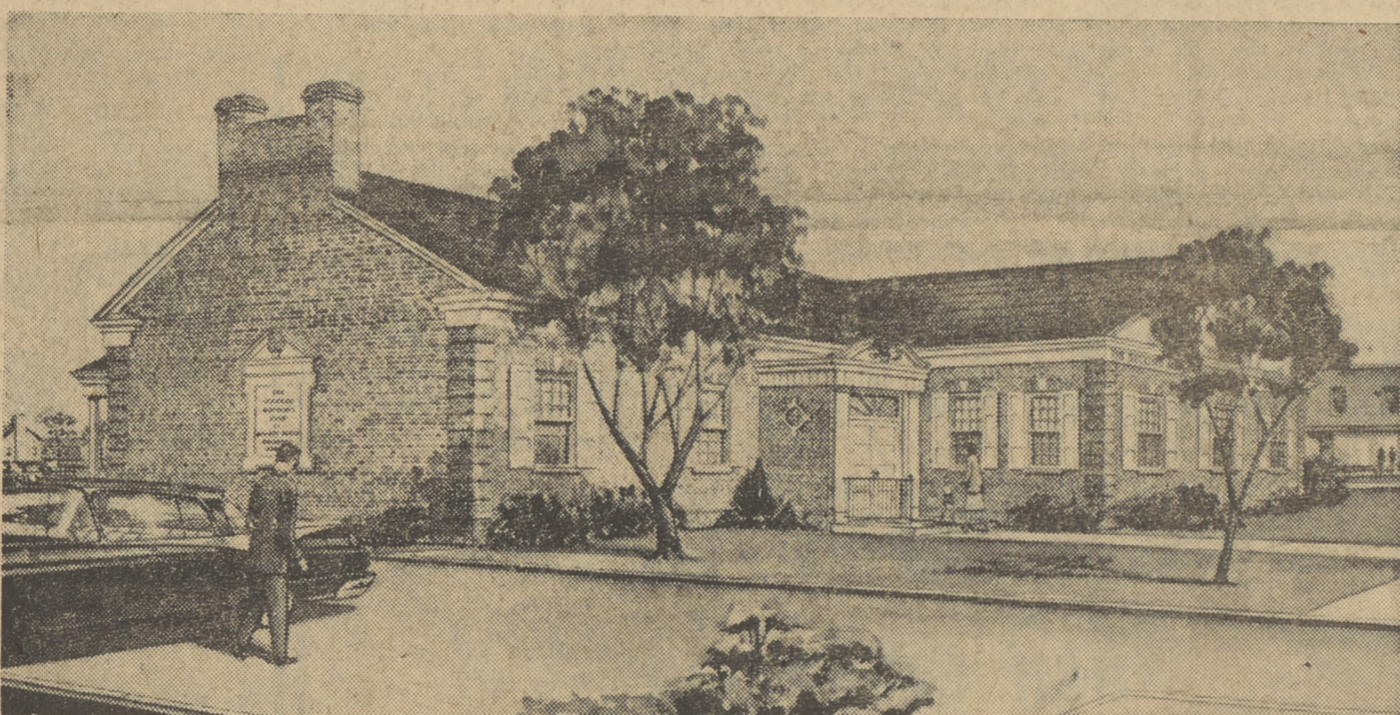
