Notice is hereby given that, at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Kingston Township, to be held on January 7, 1959, the following ordinance, to become effective January 12, 1959, will be passed:

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE STORAGE, COLLECTION, GATHERING AND/OR ACCUMULATION OF ABANDONED OR JUNKED AUTOMOBILES, TRUCKS OR OTHER VEHICLES UPON PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY; PROHIBITING THE ESTABLISHMENT, CARRYING ON, CONDUCTING AND/OR OPERATION OF AUTOMOBILE GRAVEYARDS AND/OR AUTOMOBILE JUNKYARDS UPON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR EN-

FORCEMENT THEREOF AND PRESCRIBING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Kingston, Luzerne County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, company, firm or corporation, to store, collect, gather and/or accumulate abandoned or junked automobiles upon any private or public property within the Township of Kingston, and, to establish, carry on, conduct and/or operate an automobile graveyard and/or automobile junkyard upon any private or public property within the Township of Kingston.

SECTION 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, company, firm or corporation, owning, leasing or having control over any private property within the Township of Kingston, to allow or permit any person or persons, company, firm or corporation to: (1) store, collect, gather and/or accumulate abandoned or junked automobiles upon any private property within the Township of Kingston; and, (2) to establish, carry on, conduct and/or operate an automobile graveyard and/or automobile junkyard upon any private property within the Township of Kingston.

SECTION 3. That the storage, collection, gathering and/or accumulation of abandoned or junked automobiles, trucks or other vehicles and/or the establishment, carrying on, conduct and/or operation of automobile graveyards and/or automobile junkyards shall be and is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

SECTION 4. That any person or persons, company, firm or corporation, offending or violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before a Justice of the Peace be subject to a fine or penalty in the sum of

THREE HUNDRED (\$300.00) DOLLARS and costs for each such offense or violation, or undergo imprisonment in the Luzerne County Jail or Workhouse for a period of thirty (30) days for default of the payment of such fine or penalty and costs within ten (10) days from the impositions thereof. Provided, each day's violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense. Provided further that proceedings for enforcement of the provisions of this ordinance and proceedings for the collection of fines and penalties imposed by this ordinance shall be instituted, prosecuted and completed in the manner prescribed by Clause XII of Section 702 of the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, the Second Class Township Code, as reenacted, revised, amended and consolidated.

SECTION 5. That in addition to the foregoing, the Township may pursue the additional remedies authorized by Clause XII of Section 702 of the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, The Second Class Township, as reenacted, revised, amended and consolidated, including, without limitation, the institution of proceedings in courts of equity for injunctive relief.

SECTION 6. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. That the provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any of its provisions or exceptions shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, the decision of the court shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this ordinance would have been adopted in such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provisions or exceptions had not been included herein.

SECTION 8. That this Ordinance shall become effective on January 12, 1959.
